Learning objective: To understand the elements of a story and write a descriptive paragraph

Use the writing frame to help you plan and write your story. Think about the characters, setting and plot. Use your imagination and describe what happens in your story.

1. Characters: Describe the brave knight. What were their thoughts and feelings at the beginning of the story? (2 marks)

2. Setting: What was the kingdom like? Describe the sights, sounds and smells of the kingdom. (2 marks)

3. Plot: What challenges did the brave knight face on their journey? How did they overcome them? (3 marks)

4. Story Structure: What was the turning point in the story? How did it change the plot? (3 marks)

5. Conclusion: What did the brave knight learn from their journey? What message can we take away from the story? (2 marks)

Draw: Illustrate the brave knight's journey to the legendary golden sword.



Extension challenge: Write a sequel to the story, where the brave knight faces a new challenge and must use their skills and experience to overcome it.
