

Verbal Reasoning Fun with Max and Zara

Learning objective: To develop verbal reasoning skills by identifying patterns, synonyms, antonyms, and word relationships, as per Year 4 standards.

Read the front of each flashcard carefully. Use your logic and vocabulary skills to determine the answer. Flip the card to check if you are correct!

Synonym: Find a word that means the same as 'Enormous'

Huge, giant, or massive.

Antonym: Find a word that is the opposite of 'Brave'

Cowardly, timid, or fearful.

Analogy: Max is to Monkey as Finn is to...

Dolphin.

Odd One Out: Which word does not belong? Apple, Banana, Carrot, Grape

Carrot (it is a vegetable, while the others are fruits).

Anagram: Rearrange the letters 'T-A-R-S' to make something Nova loves to watch at night

Star.

Word Relationship: If 'Happy' is to 'Smile', then 'Sad' is to...

Frown.

Suffix Challenge: Add a suffix to the word 'Help' to describe someone who is very useful

Helpful.

Prefix Challenge: Add a prefix to the word 'Happy' to mean the opposite

Unhappy.

Hidden Word: Find a 3-letter animal hidden in the word 'Starlight'

Rat.

Logic Puzzle: Zara has 3 striped shirts and 2 spotted shirts. She wears a striped one. How many shirts are left?

4 shirts.

Alphabetical Order: Which comes first: Apple, Apricot, or Ape?

Ape.

Word Build: Change one letter in 'Cat' to make a place where you sleep

Cot.
