

World Book Day Vocabulary and Literacy Challenge

Learning objective: To develop vocabulary and deepen understanding of literary terminology in preparation for World Book Day celebrations.

Read the front of each flashcard carefully. Try to recall the definition or answer before checking the 'Answer' side. Use these terms to enhance your creative writing tasks.

Protagonist	Genre
The leading character or one of the major characters in a book or story.	A particular category of artistic composition, such as mystery, fantasy, or historical fiction.
Narrator	Blurb
The person or voice telling the story to the reader.	A short, promotional description on the back of a book designed to entice a reader to pick it up.
Plot	Characterisation
The sequence of events that make up a story, including the conflict and the resolution.	The way an author reveals the personality and traits of a character through their actions, thoughts, and dialogue.
Setting	Vocabulary
The location and time period in which the action of the story takes place.	The body of words used in a particular language or by a specific author to convey meaning and imagery.
Theme	Author
The central message, moral, or big idea explored throughout a piece of writing.	The writer of a book, article, or other text.
