

Rosa's French Body Parts Adventure

Learning objective: To identify and label common parts of the body in French.

Help Rosa the parrot learn her body parts! Follow the drawing prompt to create your own character, then use the word bank to label the parts correctly.

Draw: Draw a friendly monster character in the centre of the page. The monster should have a large head, two arms, two hands, a round tummy, two legs, and two feet. Use clear, simple lines. Leave enough space around the character to draw lines from the labels in the word bank to the correct body parts.



Label words: la tête (head) · le bras (arm) · la main (hand) · la jambe (leg) · le pied (foot) · le ventre (tummy) · les yeux (eyes)

Steps:

1. Draw a line from the label 'la tête' to the head of your character.
2. Which French word from the list means 'the hand'? Write it here.
3. If Rosa has two eyes, why do we use 'les' instead of 'le' for 'les yeux'?
4. Label the leg of your character using the correct French word.
5. Draw an arrow to the tummy and label it 'le ventre'.
