

Rosa's French Body Parts Poster

Bouge ton corps ! (Move your body!) Learn these French words to describe yourself.

- **La tête** is the word for your head. Can you touch your head and say 'la tête'?
- **Les yeux** are your eyes. Look in a mirror and point to your eyes while saying 'les yeux'.
- **Le nez** is your nose. It is always helpful to remember that 'le' is used for masculine nouns.
- **Les mains** are your hands. You can use your hands to clap out the rhythm of the words!
- **Les jambes** are your legs. Use them to jump while you shout 'les jambes'!

Did you know? Did you know? In French, many body parts have a gender. We use 'le' for masculine words, 'la' for feminine words, and 'les' when we are talking about more than one (plural). Rosa the parrot says: practice by pointing to your body parts and saying the word out loud!
