

Rosa's Colourful World: Les Couleurs

Join Rosa the parrot and discover how to name the colours of the rainbow in French!

- The colour of a bright, sunny lemon is 'jaune'. Can you spot three things in our classroom that are 'jaune'?
- The colour of the deep ocean that Finn the dolphin loves is 'bleu'. How many shades of 'bleu' can you find in your paint box?
- Rosa's feathers are very colourful! If you mix 'rouge' and 'jaune' together, you create the colour 'orange'.
- Nature is full of 'vert'. Look out of the window and count how many plants or trees are 'vert'.
- When you write your name on your work, imagine the letters are 'violet'. Can you say 'violet' out loud?

Did you know? Did you know? In French, colours are adjectives that usually come after the noun they describe. For example, if you want to say 'a red car', you say 'une voiture rouge'!
