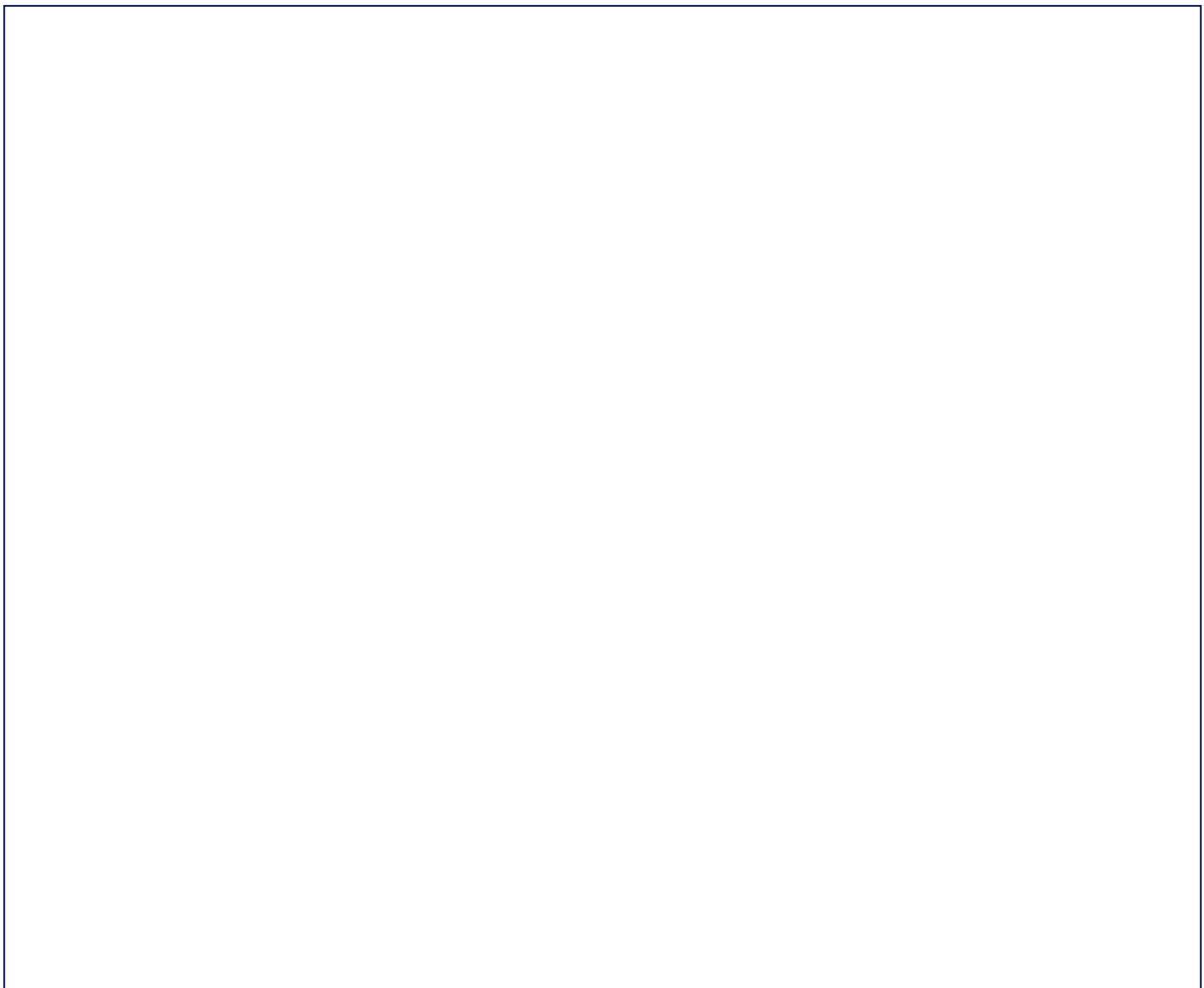


Rosa's Family Tree Drawing Sheet

Learning objective: To identify and use French vocabulary for family members to create a labelled family tree.

Use your French vocabulary to create a portrait of a family. Follow the steps below to draw your tree and label each person correctly using the words from the word bank.

Draw: Draw a large, friendly oak tree in a garden setting. The style should be clear and colourful, like a storybook illustration. In the branches, draw circular frames (like portrait bubbles) to place your family members inside. Ensure there is enough space around each portrait bubble to write the French label clearly.



Label words: le père · la mère · le frère · la sœur · le grand-père · la grand-mère · le bébé

Steps:

1. Step 1: Draw a large tree with branches. At the top, draw your grandparents. Label them using 'le grand-père' and 'la grand-mère'.
2. Step 2: Draw two adults in the middle of the tree. Label them 'le père' and 'la mère'.
3. Step 3: Draw yourself and your siblings on the lower branches. Use the words 'le frère' or 'la sœur' to label them.
4. Step 4: If you have space, draw a small baby at the bottom and label it 'le bébé'.

5. Question: Which French word would you use to describe your own mother? Write the phrase below.
