

Rosa's Tasty French Picnic

Learning objective: To identify and use French vocabulary for common food and drink items in the context of a picnic.

Rosa the parrot has prepared a wonderful picnic basket, but her shopping list is all mixed up! Look at the French words in the word bank and match them to the correct English translation in the questions below. Once you have matched them, draw a line to connect the French word to the correct item in the picnic basket scene.

Word bank: une pomme · le pain · le fromage · l'eau · un gâteau · le chocolat · une banane

1. 1. If Rosa wants an apple, which word from the bank should she pick? (Translation: Apple) (1 mark)

2. 2. Which French word describes the bread Rosa is bringing for sandwiches? (Translation: The bread) (1 mark)

3. 3. Rosa has a sweet treat for after the picnic. Which word means 'a cake'? (Translation: A cake) (1 mark)

4. 4. To stay hydrated, Rosa is bringing a bottle of water. Which word means 'the water'? (Translation: The water) (1 mark)

5. 5. Rosa loves a yellow fruit to snack on. Which word means 'a banana'? (Translation: A banana) (1 mark)

Draw: Draw a picnic blanket and place the following items on it: a red apple, a loaf of bread, a slice of cheese, a bottle of water, a chocolate cake, and a yellow banana. Label each item with its correct French name from the word bank.



Extension challenge: Imagine you are going to the market with Rosa. Write a short French shopping list for three more items you would like to have at your picnic, using a dictionary to help you find the French words for your favourite snacks.
