

Rosa's Greetings Garden

Learning objective: To be able to identify and use basic French greetings and farewells in a creative context.

Follow the drawing prompt to create your scene. Once your drawing is complete, label the characters using the French words from the word bank provided below.

Draw: Create a sunny, colourful garden scene. In the centre, draw Rosa the parrot perched on a tree branch. Around her, draw three other characters (a child, a farmer, or another animal friend) meeting for the first time. Use speech bubbles to show them using the greetings from the word bank. Ensure your drawings are clear and you have plenty of space to add your French labels next to each character.



Label words: Bonjour · Salut · Au revoir · À bientôt · Comment ça va ?

Steps:

1. Draw Rosa the parrot sitting on a branch saying 'Bonjour' to a friend. Label the greeting.
2. Draw a character waving goodbye as they leave the garden. Label this farewell in French.
3. If you were meeting a new friend in the garden, which French phrase would you use to ask how they are feeling?
4. Write the French word for 'Hello' (formal) and the French word for 'Goodbye'.
5. Why do you think it is important to greet people in different languages? Give one reason.
