

Rosa's French Greetings Diary

Learning objective: To use and understand common French greetings and polite phrases appropriate for Year 4.

Rosa the parrot is learning how to greet her friends in different languages. Use this template to practise your own French greetings. Imagine you are meeting a friend at different times of the day and write down the correct phrases you would use.

Word bank: Bonjour · Salut · Bonsoir · Au revoir · À bientôt · Comment ça va? · Ça va bien · Merci

1. Morning Greeting: It is 9:00 am and you see your friend. Write the French greeting you would use to say 'Hello' and ask them how they are. (2 marks)

2. The Reply: How would your friend reply in French to say 'I am doing well, thank you'? (2 marks)

3. Evening Greeting: You are leaving a party at 7:00 pm. Write the French phrase for 'Good evening' and 'Goodbye'. (2 marks)

4. Informal Greeting: You see a close friend in the park. Which informal French word from the word bank would you use to say 'Hi'? (1 mark)

5. Future Meeting: How would you say 'See you soon' in French to your friend as you walk away? (1 mark)

Extension challenge: Choose two of your phrases and write a short script for a conversation between two characters meeting for the first time.
