

Year 4 French Assessment: Les Mois de l'Année

Learning objective: To recall, identify, and write the twelve months of the year in French and use them in context.

Read each question carefully. Use the word bank to help you with spelling. Write your answers clearly in the spaces provided.

Rosa the parrot is busy making a calendar for her friends. She has noted that Leo the lion celebrates his birthday when the flowers bloom in spring, and Bea the bee loves the warm sun in the middle of summer.

Word bank: janvier · février · mars · avril · mai · juin · juillet · août · septembre · octobre · novembre · décembre

1. Rosa is teaching you the months. Write the French word for the first month of the year (January) and the last month of the year (December). (2 marks)

2. Put these three months in the correct order as they appear in the calendar: octobre, août, septembre. (3 marks)

3. If today is in 'juin' (June), what is the month that comes immediately after? (2 marks)

4. Match the season to the month: Which two months from the word bank are typically the coldest winter months in the UK? Write them in French. (4 marks)

5. Max the monkey is planning a party. He wants to have it in the month of May. Write a full sentence in French saying: 'My birthday is in May.' (Hint: 'Mon anniversaire est en...') (4 marks)

6. Rosa wants to know about your year! Write a short paragraph in French (at least 3 sentences) describing when your birthday is, one month you like, and one month you do not like as much. Use: 'J'aime...' (I like), 'Je n'aime pas...' (I do not like), and 'Mon anniversaire est en...' (My birthday is in...). (10 marks)

Draw: Draw a picture of your favourite month of the year. Include a small label in French showing the name of that month.
