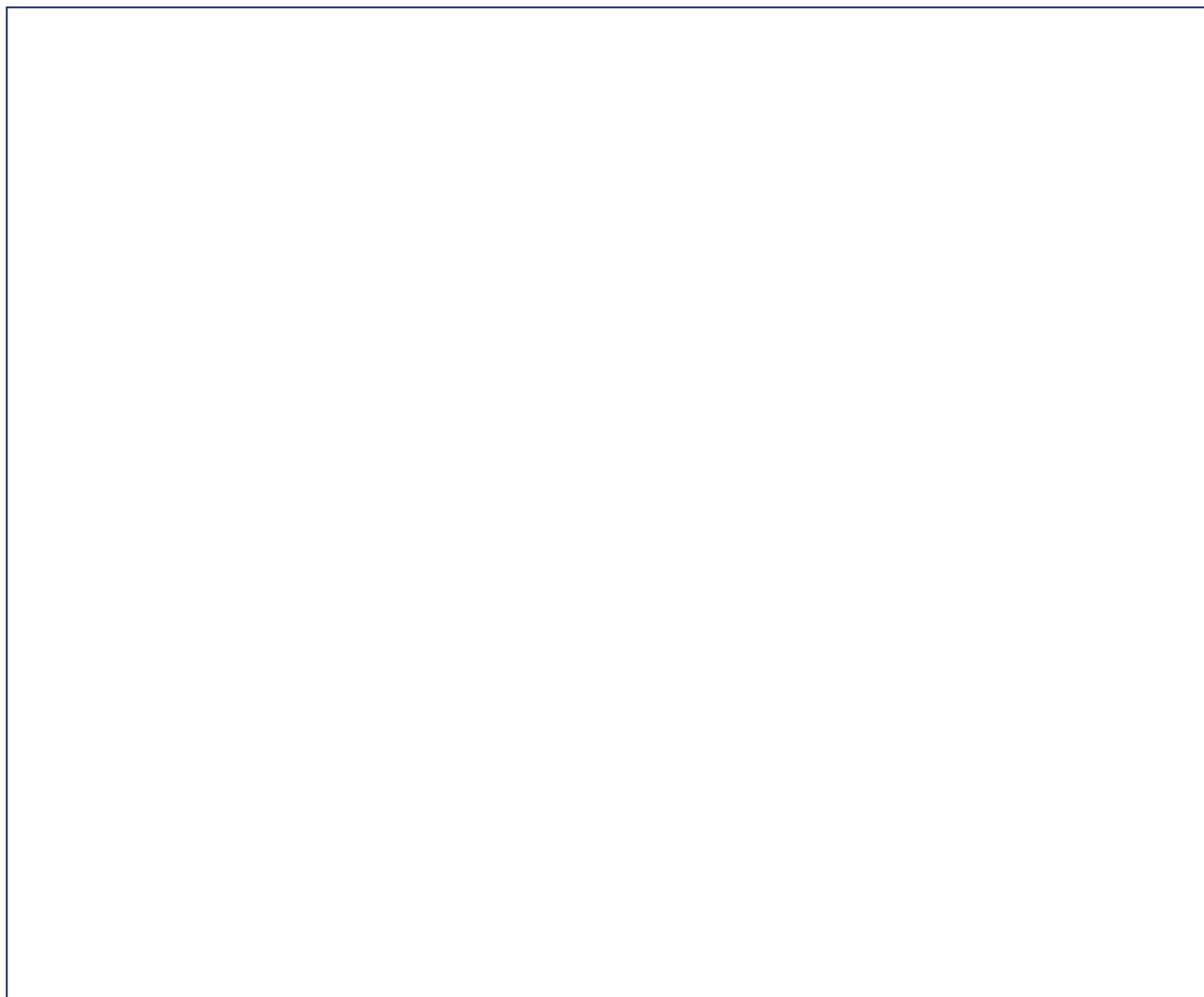


Rosa's Sports Day Drawing Challenge

Learning objective: To identify and use French vocabulary for common sports and activities.

Help Rosa the parrot prepare for a sports day! Use the word bank to label the sports equipment you draw on the playing field below. Make sure to use the correct French term for each item.

Draw: Create a large, colourful sports scene on a playing field. Ensure there is plenty of white space around your drawn objects so you have room to write the labels from the word bank clearly next to each sport item. Use bright colours for the equipment.



Label words: le football (football) · le tennis (tennis) · le basket (basketball) · le rugby (rugby) · la natation (swimming) · le vélo (cycling)

Steps:

1. Step 1: Draw a football pitch. Inside the pitch, draw a ball and label it 'le football'.
2. Step 2: Draw a tennis racket and a ball near the edge of the pitch. Label these 'le tennis'.
3. Step 3: Draw a basketball hoop at one end of the court. Label it 'le basket'.
4. Step 4: Draw a bicycle in the corner of your scene. Label it 'le vélo'.
5. Step 5: Write a French sentence at the bottom of your page to say which sport is your favourite, for example: 'J'aime le football.'
