

Rosa's Sports Day Challenge

Learning objective: To learn and use vocabulary related to sports in French, including the verbs 'jouer au' (to play) and 'faire de' (to do).

Welcome to the sports field! Rosa the parrot is here to help you practise your French sports vocabulary. Read the questions carefully and remember to use the correct grammar when talking about your favourite activities.

Word bank: le football (football) · le tennis (tennis) · le basket (basketball) · le rugby (rugby) · la natation (swimming) · la gymnastique (gymnastics) · le judo (judo) · Je joue au... (I play...) · Je fais de la... (I do...)

1. Rosa wants to know what you play. Write a sentence in French to say 'I play football'. (2 marks)

2. When we talk about individual sports like swimming or gymnastics, we use 'Je fais de la...'. Write a sentence in French to say 'I do gymnastics'. (2 marks)

3. Look at these two sports: le basket and le judo. Which one uses the phrase 'Je joue au' and which one uses 'Je fais de la'? Explain why. (3 marks)

4. Translate this sentence into English: 'Je joue au tennis avec mon ami.' (2 marks)

5. Imagine you are at the sports centre. Write two sentences in French: one sport you enjoy playing and one sport you enjoy doing. (4 marks)

Draw: Draw yourself participating in your favourite sport. Label your drawing in French using the vocabulary from the word bank (e.g., draw a football and write 'le football' next to it).



Extension challenge: Research one other sport in French that is not in the word bank and write a sentence explaining if you like it or not, using 'J'aime...' (I like) or 'Je n'aime pas...' (I do not like).
