

Rosa's French Transport Assessment

Learning objective: To identify and use French vocabulary for different modes of transport and express travel preferences.

Read each question carefully. Rosa the parrot has provided a word bank to help you. Write your answers clearly in the spaces provided.

Rosa the parrot is planning a holiday across France. She likes to travel in many different ways. Sometimes she flies through the clouds, and sometimes she prefers to stay on the ground to look at the beautiful patterns Zara the zebra has painted on the landscape.

Word bank: en train (by train) · en voiture (by car) · en avion (by plane) · en bateau (by boat) · en bus (by bus) · à vélo (by bike) · à pied (on foot) · préféré (favourite)

1. 1. Write the French words for these three modes of transport: Car, Train, and Boat. (3 marks)

2. 2. If Rosa is walking to the park, which French phrase should she use to describe how she is travelling? (2 marks)

3. 3. Translate this sentence into English: 'Je vais à l'école en bus.' (3 marks)

4. 4. Match the transport to the environment: Where would you most likely use 'en bateau' and where would you use 'en avion'? Explain your reasoning. (4 marks)

5. 5. Max the monkey wants to travel to the mountains. Write a sentence in French explaining how he travels (e.g., I go by...) and one reason why he likes it. (4 marks)

6. 6. Extended Writing: Rosa is choosing her transport for a trip to Paris. Write a short paragraph (3-5 sentences) in French stating your favourite way to travel and why. Use the word 'préfééré'. (5 marks)

7. 7. If a train ticket costs £12 and a bus ticket costs £4, what is the total cost in pounds if you buy one of each? (4 marks)
