

## Rosa's French Transport Adventure!

Hop on board and travel through France with Rosa the parrot!

- To say you are travelling by bicycle in French, you use the phrase 'en vélo'.
- If you are going by car, you say 'en voiture'.
- When you catch a bus, you say 'en bus'.
- To travel by train, you use the phrase 'en train'.
- If you are flying, you say 'en avion'.
- Remember: when walking, we say 'à pied' instead of 'en'!

*Did you know? Did you know? France has a very famous high-speed train called the TGV, which stands for 'Train à Grande Vitesse'. It is one of the fastest trains in the world and can travel at speeds of up to 200 miles per hour!*
