

Rosa's French Action Adventure

Learning objective: To recognise and use high-frequency French verbs in the present tense, including 'être' (to be) and 'avoir' (to have).

Help Rosa the parrot learn her French verbs! Use the word bank to complete the sentences and show off your knowledge of French grammar.

Word bank: suis · est · ai · a · mangent · jouent

1. Rosa says, 'Je _____ une perroquet.' (I am a parrot). Which verb from the word bank should she use? (1 mark)

2. Fill in the blank: 'Il _____ un grand livre.' (He has a big book). Use the correct form of 'avoir'. (1 mark)

3. Translate this sentence into English: 'Ils jouent au football.' (2 marks)

4. Complete the sentence using the correct verb form: 'Elle _____ très intelligente.' (She is very intelligent). (1 mark)

5. If 'Les enfants' (the children) are eating, would you use 'mangent' or 'a'? Explain why. (2 marks)

Extension challenge: Choose two verbs from the word bank and write your own original French sentence for each one. Try to add an extra word, such as a colour (rouge, bleu) or a number.
