What is the largest continent in the world?

Asia: the largest continent, covering about one-third of the Earth's land area.

Which ocean is between the continents of Asia and Africa?

Indian Ocean: an ocean located between Asia and Africa.

What is the smallest continent?

Australia: the smallest continent, also known as Oceania.

Which continents are joined by the Isthmus of Suez?

Africa and Asia: the continents of Africa and Asia are connected by the Isthmus of Suez.

Which ocean is the largest of the five?

Pacific Ocean: the largest of the five oceans, covering over 155 million square kilometres.

What is the continent where the city of Rio de Janeiro is located?

South America: a continent that includes countries such as Brazil, Argentina, and Chile.

What is the ocean that surrounds the continent of Africa?

Atlantic Ocean: an ocean that surrounds the continent of Africa.

Which continents are separated by the Drake Passage?

Antarctica and South America: the continents of Antarctica and South America are separated by the Drake Passage.

What is the continent where the city of Beijing is located?

Asia: a continent that includes countries such as China, Japan, and Korea.

Which ocean is located between the continents of Asia and Australia?

Pacific Ocean: an ocean that connects the continents of Asia and Australia.
