

Finn's Great Geography Sort

Learning objective: To distinguish between human and physical geographical features.

Finn the dolphin is travelling around the world and has spotted many different things! Look at the list of features in the word bank. Decide if each one is a 'Physical Feature' (something made by nature) or a 'Human Feature' (something built by people). Write the words into the correct column on your activity sheet.

Word bank: Mountain · Bridge · River · City · Waterfall · Motorway · Valley · Factory · Coastline · Airport

1. Which features from the list are Physical? (List all that apply) (5 marks)

2. Which features from the list are Human? (List all that apply) (5 marks)

3. Explain why a 'River' is a physical feature rather than a human one. (2 marks)

4. Explain why a 'Bridge' is a human feature rather than a physical one. (2 marks)

5. If Finn found a village next to a lake, which one is the human feature and which is the physical feature? (2 marks)

6. Can a human feature be built using materials from a physical feature? Give one example. (2 marks)

Draw: Draw a picture of a landscape that contains at least three physical features and three human features. Label each one clearly!



Extension challenge: Think of a place you have visited. List two physical features and two human features that you saw there.
