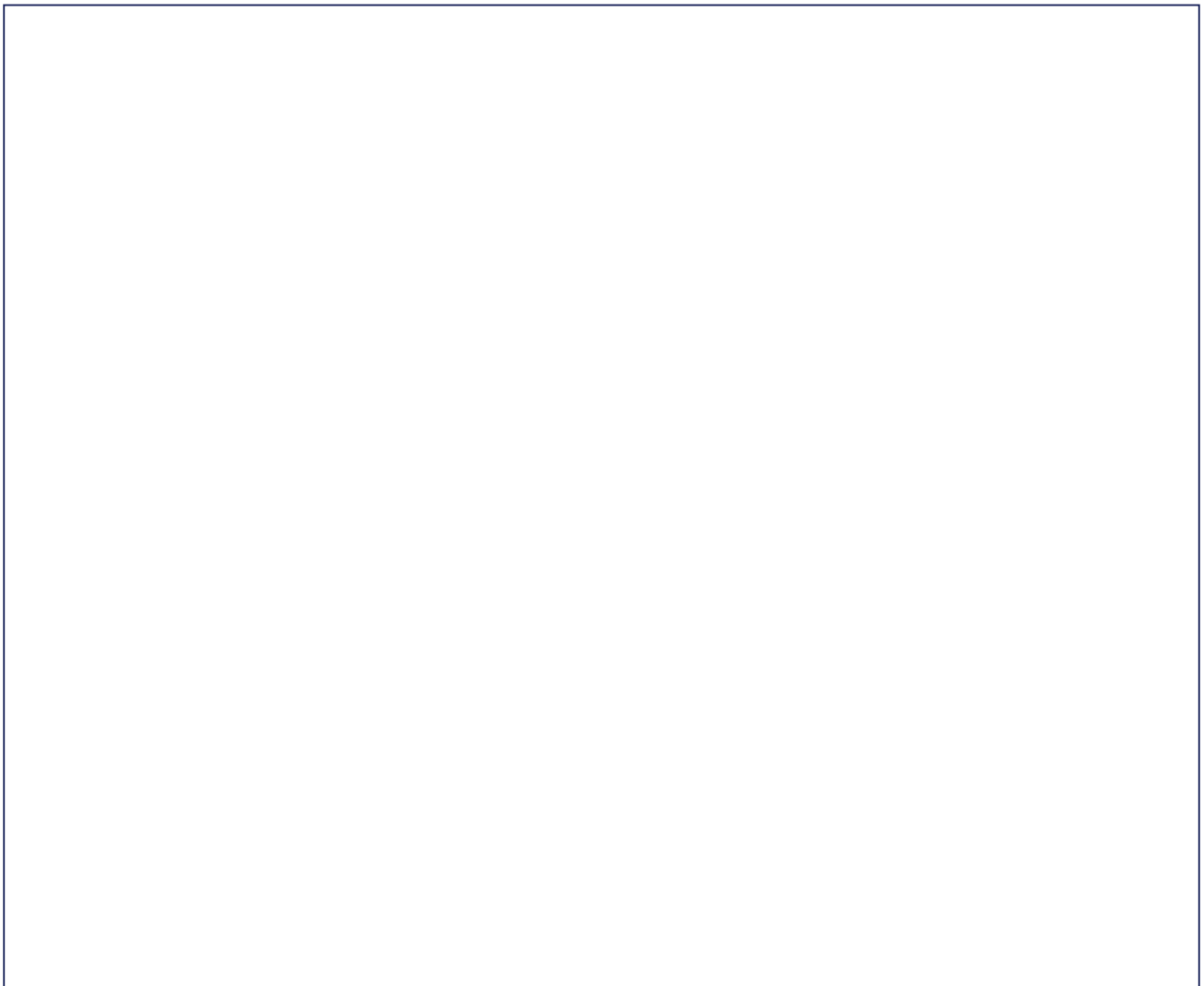


Volcanoes: A Magma Flow

Learning objective: To understand the basic concept of a volcano and its features.

Use your imagination to create a drawing of a volcano in action. Think about what you have learned about volcanoes and what features they have.

Draw: Draw a volcano with a mountainous base, a crater at the top, and lava flowing out of the volcanic vent. Include steam rising from the crater and a landscape of trees and a village in the background. Use different colours to show the different textures and features. Consider what you would do if you were living near a volcano like this.



Label words: Volcano · Magma · Lava · Steam · Crater · Mountain

Steps:

1. Label the volcano's crater.
2. Draw lava flowing out of the volcano's vent.
3. What is the volcano's base made of? (e.g. rock, mountain, hill)
4. Draw steam rising from the volcano's crater.
5. Write 'Magma' next to the volcano's lava flow.
