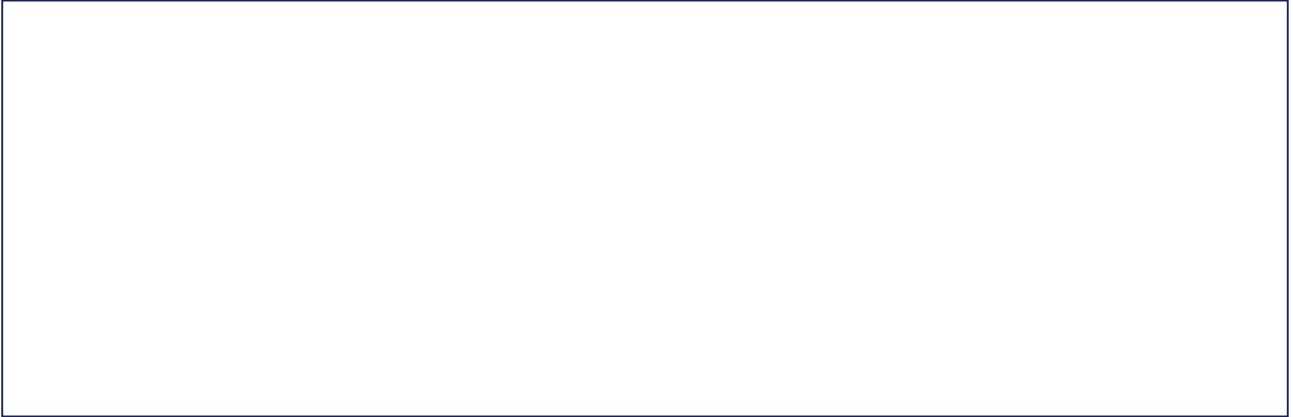
7. Where can you find different types of volcanoes in the world? (Choose one: mountains of the Himalayas, islands of the Pacific, deserts of Africa) (1 mark)
