

Ellie's Ancient Egypt Adventure

Learning objective: To identify and illustrate key features of Ancient Egyptian civilisation and understand their purpose.

Help Ellie the elephant explore the banks of the River Nile. Use your knowledge of Ancient Egypt to create a detailed scene. Label your drawing using the words provided in the word bank.

Draw: Create a landscape scene of Ancient Egypt. Include the River Nile winding through the sand. On one side of the river, draw a large pyramid with a golden capstone. On the other side, draw a market scene with a scribe holding a scroll made of papyrus. Use a warm colour palette of oranges, yellows, and browns to show the desert sun, and bright blues for the river water. The style should be clear and descriptive, like a history textbook illustration.



Label words: River Nile · Pharaoh · Pyramid · Papyrus · Hieroglyphs · Sarcophagus

Steps:

1. Why was the River Nile so important to the people living in Ancient Egypt?
2. What was the purpose of a sarcophagus?
3. Step 1: Draw the River Nile flowing through the centre of your page.
4. Step 2: Draw a large pyramid in the distance and label it.
5. Step 3: Draw a person holding a piece of papyrus and label it.
