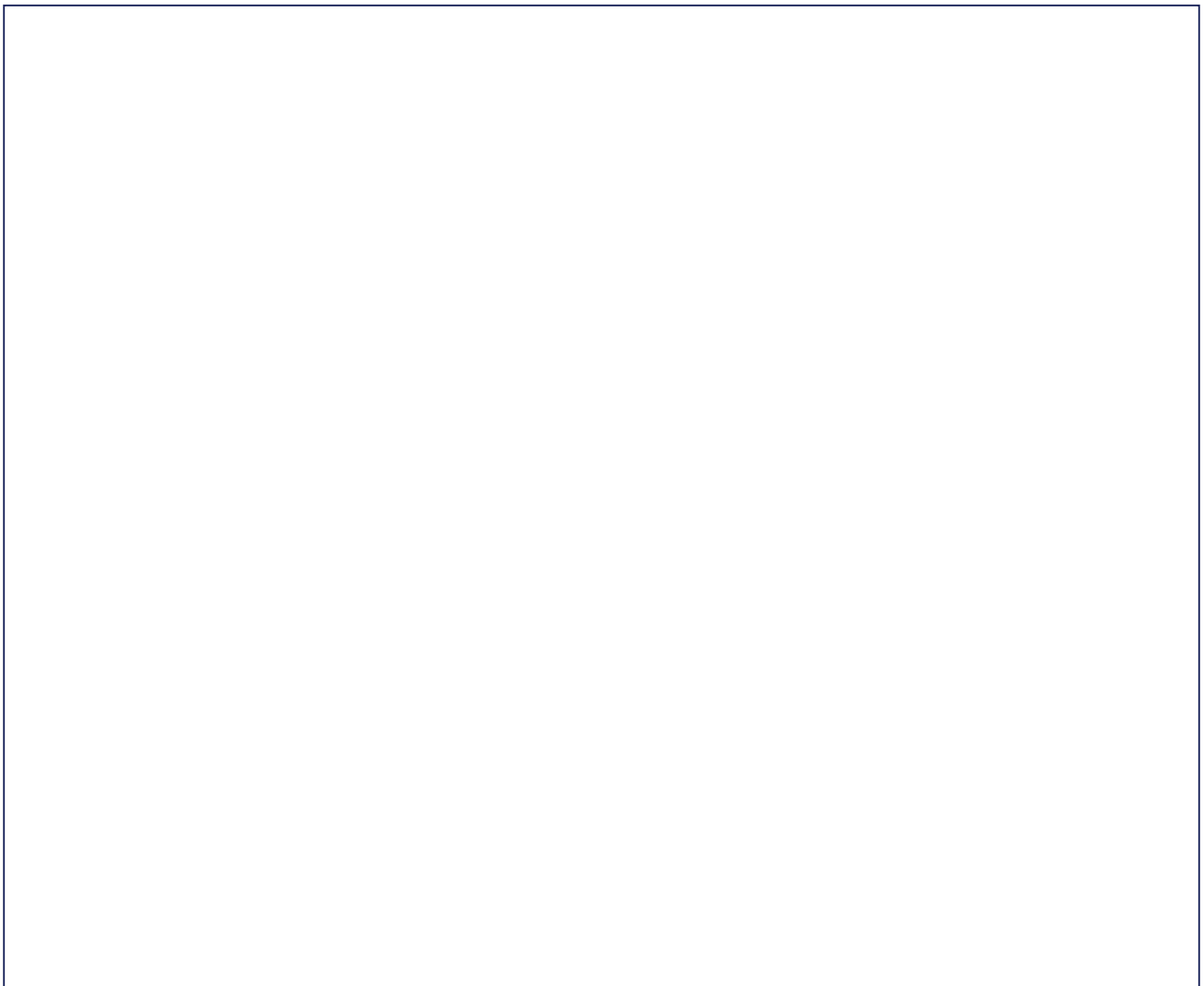


Remembrance Day: A Tribute to Peace

Learning objective: To understand the significance of Remembrance Day and identify key symbols associated with commemorating those who served in wars.

Follow the steps below to create a commemorative scene. Use your drawing to show respect and reflection. When you have finished, use the word bank to label your work.

Draw: Create a peaceful, respectful scene. Draw a vibrant red poppy in the foreground with black seeds in the centre. In the background, draw a stone memorial plaque or a wreath made of flowers and leaves. Use soft colours to create a reflective mood. You may add a calm sky or a field of grass behind your main objects.



Label words: Poppy · Wreath · Medal · Silence · Peace · Remembrance

Steps:

1. Step 1: Draw a large poppy in the centre of your page. Why is the poppy used as a symbol for this day?
2. Step 2: Draw a wreath leaning against a memorial stone. What do you think a two-minute silence represents?
3. Step 3: Label your drawing using at least four words from the word bank provided.
4. Ellie the elephant is visiting a memorial. Write one sentence about why it is important to remember history.
5. What date is Remembrance Day held each year?
