

Addition Worksheet

Learning objective: To practice adding two-digit numbers in a variety of contexts.

Solve the following addition problems. Remember to add carefully and show your working.

Word bank: add · sum · numbers · digits · equals

1. Add 24 and 37. (2 marks)

2. Find the sum of 56 and 48. (2 marks)

3. Max and Ellie collected 32 seashells and 29 pebbles respectively. How many items did they collect altogether? (2 marks)

4. Finn explored two oceans. The first ocean had 45 islands, and the second ocean had 39 islands. How many islands did he explore in total? (2 marks)

5. Add 78 and 22, and then add 15 to the sum. (2 marks)

Draw: Draw a picture of a beach with seashells and pebbles that Max and Ellie might collect.



Extension challenge: Create a word problem using the numbers from any of the addition questions above. Think of a real-life scenario where these numbers could be used.
