Learning objective: To understand and use standard units of measurement for length, mass, and capacity.

Answer the following questions to show your understanding of measurement units. Use the units provided in the word bank.

Word bank: centimetres · metres · kilograms · grams · litres · millilitres

1. If a banana is 15 centimetres long, how many millimetres is it? (2 marks)

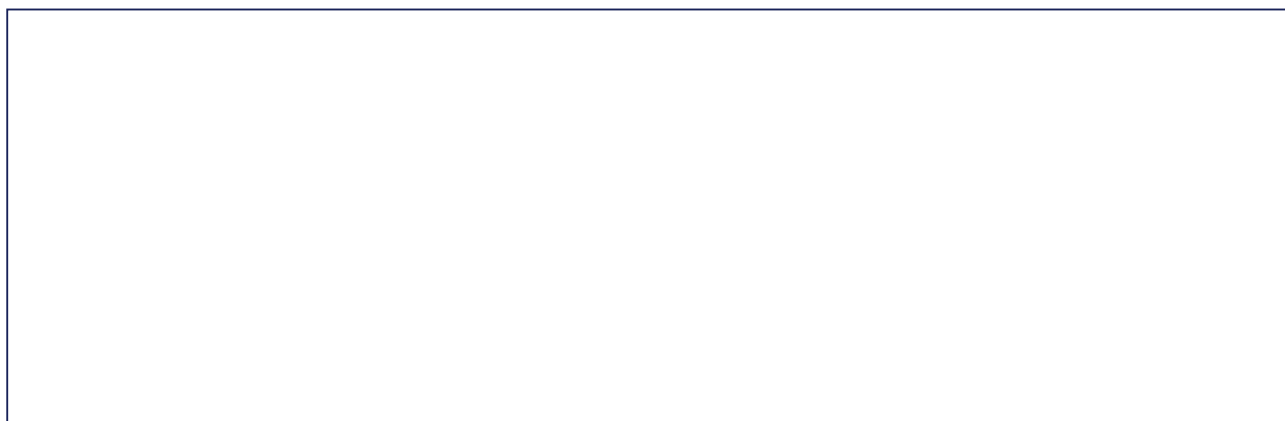
2. A water bottle holds 500 millilitres of water. How many millilitres are needed to make 1 litre? (2 marks)

3. Max weighs 35 kilograms. If his friend Pip weighs 15 kilograms, how much heavier is Max? (2 marks)

4. A classroom is 8 metres long. How many centimetres is that? (2 marks)

5. Ellie has 2 kilograms of flour. If she uses 500 grams for baking, how many grams will she have left? (3 marks)

Draw: Draw a picture of a ruler and label the centimetres and one metre.



Extension challenge: Create a simple recipe that uses measurements from the word bank. Write down the measurements and ingredients needed for your recipe.
