*Learning objective: To identify and understand key musical elements including tempo, dynamics, pitch, and duration.*

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**3. 3. If a musician is playing very loudly or very quietly, which musical element are they changing? (1 mark)**

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**4. 4. Which word describes a note that sounds like a bird chirping? A) Low B) High\* C) Deep D) Heavy (1 mark)**

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**5. 5. True or False: A 'Crescendo' means the music is gradually getting louder. (1 mark)**

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**6. 6. Which term describes music played in a smooth, connected style? A) Staccato B) Tempo C) Legato\* D) Silence (1 mark)**

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**7. 7. What word describes the length of time a musical sound lasts? (1 mark)**

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**8. 8. What do we call it when music starts quiet and gets louder? A) Diminuendo B) Crescendo\* C) Duration D) Beat (1 mark)**

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**9. 9. True or False: The 'beat' is the steady pulse that you can tap your foot to in a song. (1 mark)**

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10. 10. What is the word for short, detached, 'bouncy' notes? (1 mark)
