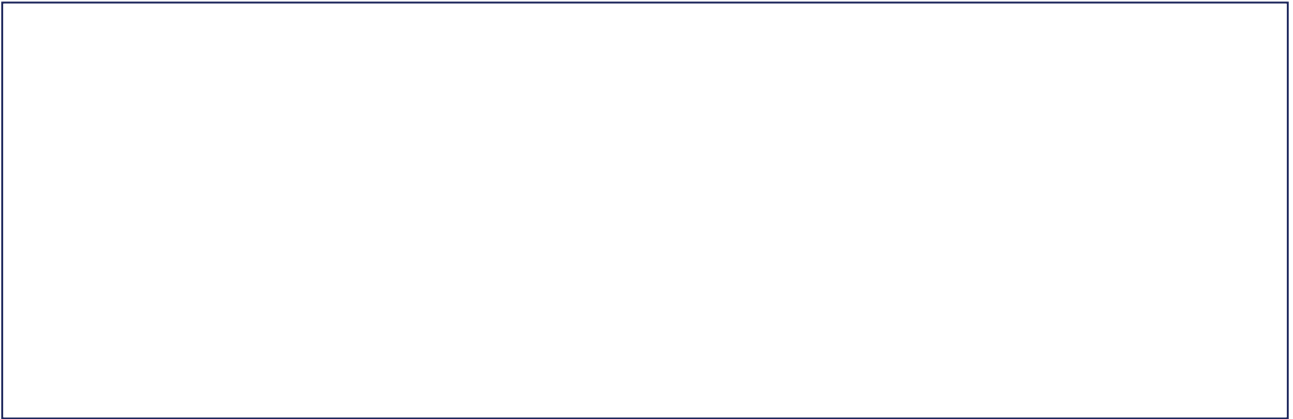
1. Describe the landscape we explored. (3 marks)
