Learning objective: To understand how to stay safe, respectful, and responsible when using the internet and digital devices.

Use this fact-file to help Kit the Fox create a guide for staying safe online. Think about the rules you follow at home and school to keep your personal information private and your interactions kind.

2. Strong Passwords: If you were helping Kit create a secure password, what are three things you should include to make it difficult for others to guess? (3 marks)

3. Being Kind: If someone sends you an unkind message or makes you feel worried while you are playing a game or using an app, what steps should you take? (2 marks)

4. Trusted Adults: List three adults you know in real life that you could talk to if you ever felt uncomfortable or unsure about something you saw online. (2 marks)

5. Digital Balance: Why is it important to balance your time spent on a screen with other activities like reading with Pip or stargazing with Nova? (2 marks)

Extension challenge: Design a 'Digital Safety Poster' that features Kit the Fox giving one piece of advice to other children about how to be a good digital citizen.
