Learning objective: To understand the meaning and traditions of Eid al-Fitr and Eid al-Adha within the Islamic faith.

Answer the following questions about the festivals of Eid. Use the word bank to help you with your spelling where needed.

Word bank: fasting · charity · community · mosque · Zakat · celebration · sacrifice

- 1. What is the name of the festival that marks the end of Ramadan, the month of fasting? (1 mark)**

- 2. Why is the act of giving to charity (Zakat) an important part of the Eid celebrations? (2 marks)**

- 3. Max the monkey is helping his friends prepare for Eid. Name two things a family might do to get their home or themselves ready for the celebration. (2 marks)**

- 4. Eid al-Adha remembers a story of faith and sacrifice. How do people show their faith during this specific festival? (2 marks)**

- 5. Many Muslims visit a mosque or gather with their community for a special prayer on Eid morning. Why is spending time with family and friends so important during these festivals? (2 marks)**

- 6. If a child received £5.00 as an 'Eidi' gift, and they decided to give half of it to a charity, how much money would they donate? (1 mark)**
