4. The symbol 'Om' is very important in Hinduism. Describe what it represents or how it is used. (2 marks)

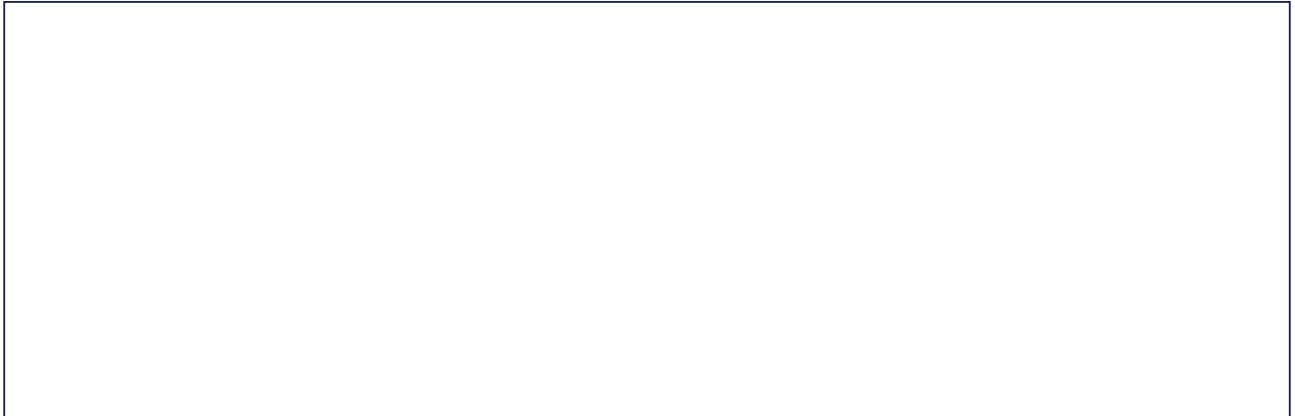
5. What is 'Karma'? Explain how a person's actions might affect their future according to this belief. (3 marks)

6. Diwali is known as the Festival of Lights. Describe two ways that families might celebrate Diwali at home or in their community. (4 marks)

8. Imagine you are explaining Hinduism to a friend. Write a short paragraph explaining why the concept of 'Dharma' (living a good, righteous life) is important for a Hindu. (8 marks)
