1. What is the name of the holy book for Muslims? (1 mark)

2. Who is the final Prophet in Islam, who shared the message of Allah with others? (1 mark)

3. What is a mosque, and what happens inside one? (2 marks)

4. Muslims follow the Five Pillars of Islam. List three of the Five Pillars from the word bank. (3 marks)

5. Explain what 'Sawm' (fasting) is during the month of Ramadan. Why do Muslims do this? (4 marks)

6. Describe the pilgrimage to Makkah (Hajj). Where do Muslims go, and why is this journey important? (4 marks)

7. Imagine you are explaining Islam to a friend who knows nothing about it. Write a short paragraph describing how a Muslim's faith might influence how they treat other people and the world around them. Mention the idea of kindness or charity (Zakat). (5 marks)
