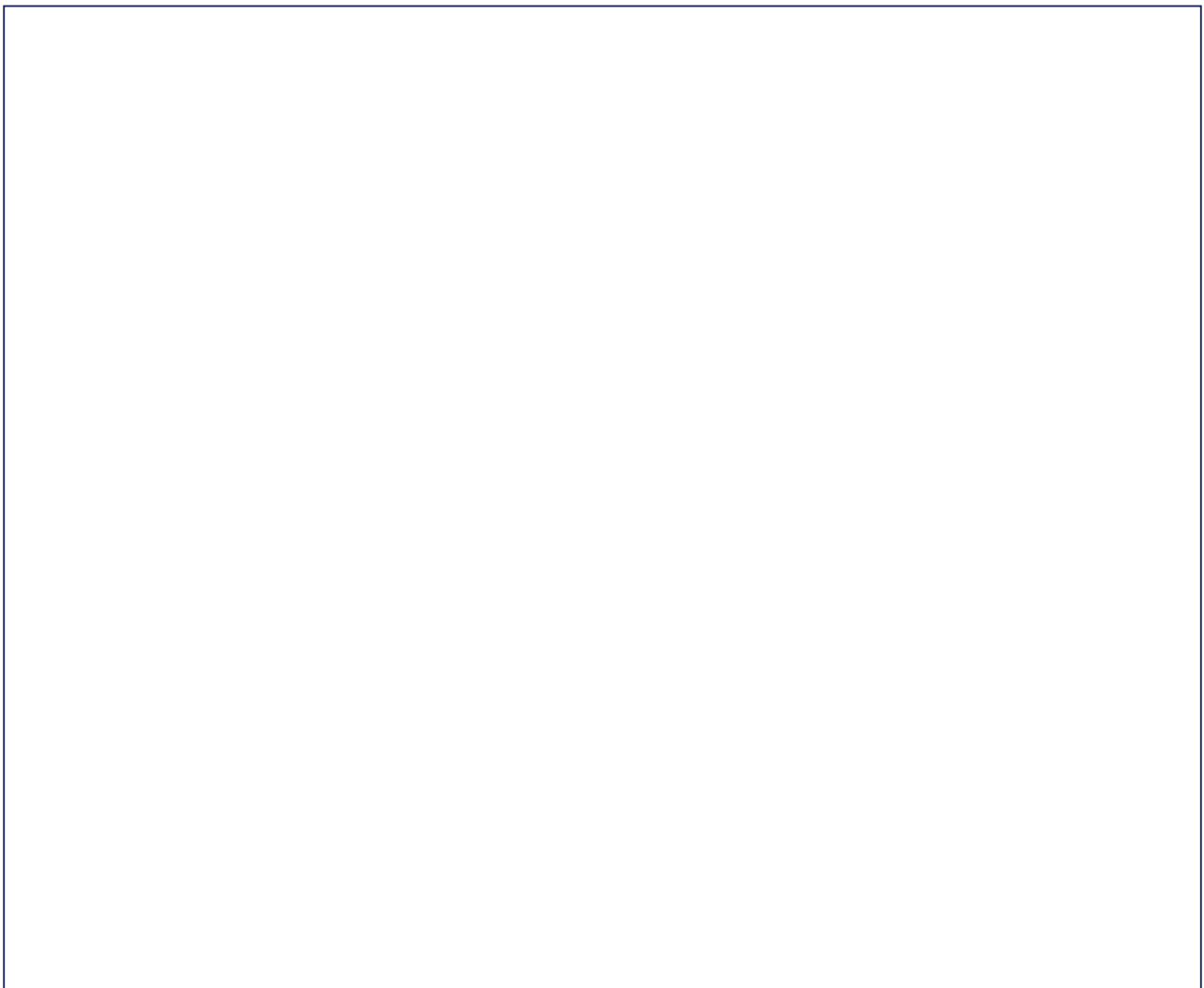


A Journey of Faith: Understanding Pilgrimage

Learning objective: To understand the meaning of a pilgrimage and identify key features and reasons why believers undertake a journey of faith.

Follow the steps below to create a detailed scene showing a pilgrim on their journey. Use the word bank to add labels to your drawing.

Draw: Create a landscape scene showing a winding path leading towards a beautiful, peaceful building or natural landmark (the sacred site). Include a character (the pilgrim) wearing comfortable walking clothes and carrying a rucksack. The style should be warm and inviting, using soft colours. Include details like trees, a bright sun, or a signpost to show the direction of the journey.



Label words: Pilgrim · Sacred site · Reflection · Prayer · Journey · Community · Devotion

Steps:

1. Step 1: Draw a pilgrim walking along a path. What is one item they might carry to help them on their journey? Draw it in their bag.
2. Step 2: Label the path they are walking on. Why is a pilgrimage considered a 'journey of faith' rather than just a normal holiday?
3. Step 3: Draw a destination at the end of the path. Label it 'Sacred Site'. What might a person do when they

arrive at this special place?

4. Step 4: Draw a symbol near the pilgrim that represents peace or reflection. Explain why this symbol is important to their journey.

5. Final Task: Nova the Owl wants to know: If you were going on a journey to learn more about yourself, what is one quality or feeling you would hope to find at the end?
