6. 6. True or False: The Sun is a planet. (1 mark)

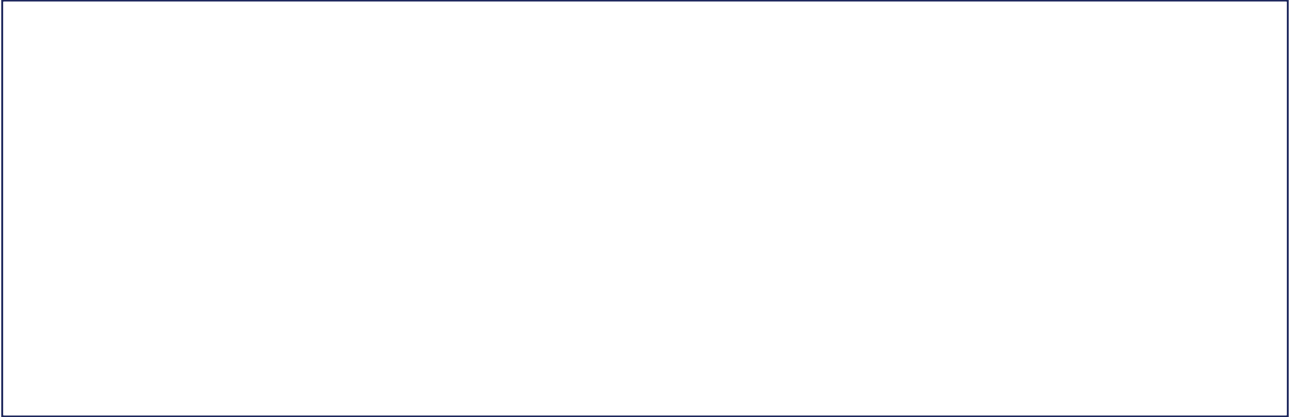
7. 7. What force keeps the planets in orbit around the Sun? A) Magnetism B) Friction *C) Gravity D) Electricity (1 mark)
