1. 1. I have four legs, a wagging tail, and I love to bark. What am I? (In Spanish: _____) (2 marks)

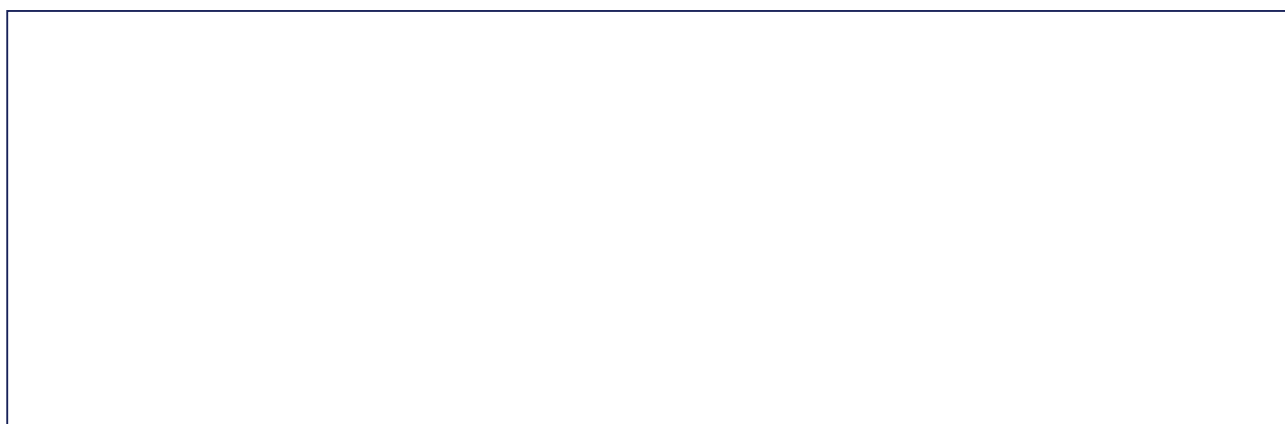
2. 2. I am small, have wings, and I love to sing in the trees. What am I? (In Spanish: _____) (2 marks)
