

Rosa's Animal Art Adventure

Learning objective: To learn and use Spanish vocabulary for common animals while creating a labelled illustration.

Help Rosa the parrot explore the animal kingdom! Follow the drawing prompt to create your scene, then use the Spanish word bank to label your animals correctly in the boxes provided.

Draw: Create a vibrant, colourful scene on a sheet of A4 paper. Start by drawing a sunny landscape with a large oak tree on one side and a sparkling blue pond on the other. Use clear, bold lines for your animals so that you have enough space to write the Spanish labels next to each one. You might want to use coloured pencils to make your animals look realistic or bright and patterned like Zara the zebra would!



Label words: el perro (dog) · el gato (cat) · el pájaro (bird) · el león (lion) · el elefante (elephant) · el delfín (dolphin)

Steps:

1. Draw a large tree in the centre of your page. Label the bird sitting in the branches using the correct Spanish word from the bank.
2. Draw a lion resting under the tree. Label the lion in Spanish.
3. Draw a small pond near the lion and add a dolphin jumping out of the water. Label the dolphin in Spanish.

4. Draw a friendly elephant standing near the pond. Label the elephant in Spanish.
5. Add a dog and a cat playing in the grass. Label them both in Spanish.
