

Rosa's Spanish Body Parts Challenge

Learning objective: To identify and label parts of the body in Spanish using the correct vocabulary.

Help Rosa the parrot learn about anatomy! Follow the drawing prompt below to create your own character. Once your character is drawn, use the word bank to label the correct body parts in Spanish.

Draw: In the centre of your page, draw a friendly, original character. You could draw a robot, an alien, or a fantastical forest creature. Make sure the character has a clear head, two arms, two hands, two legs, and two feet so you have plenty of space to add your Spanish labels. Use a pencil to sketch, then go over your lines with a black pen. Add neat arrows pointing from your labels to the specific parts of the body.



Label words: la cabeza (head) · el brazo (arm) · la mano (hand) · la pierna (leg) · el pie (foot) · los ojos (eyes) · la boca (mouth)

Steps:

1. Draw a line from the label 'la mano' to the correct part of your drawing.
2. Which word in the word bank is plural? Write it down.
3. If you wanted to say 'the arm' in Spanish, would you use 'el' or 'la'?
4. Label the 'la cabeza' on your drawing.
5. Write a short sentence in Spanish describing one body part you have drawn, for example: 'Esta es la

mano'.
