- **La cabeza** is the Spanish word for your head. Try to touch your head and say the word out loud!
- **Los ojos** are your eyes. Can you count how many eyes you have in Spanish? (Uno, dos!)
- **La boca** is used for speaking. Practise saying 'Hola' using your boca.
- **Las manos** are your hands. You use them to write, draw, and wave hello to your friends.
- **Las piernas** help you walk to school, and **los pies** are what you use to wear your favourite shoes.
