

Rosa's Body Parts Fact-File

Learning objective: To identify and write the names of body parts in Spanish, following the Year 4 curriculum for foreign languages.

Join Rosa the parrot on her language adventure! Use the word bank to help you label your fact-file. Write the Spanish word for each body part and describe its function in English. Remember to check your spellings carefully.

Word bank: la cabeza (head) · los brazos (arms) · las manos (hands) · las piernas (legs) · los pies (feet) · los ojos (eyes) · la boca (mouth)

1. My Head: Write the Spanish word for head and describe one thing you use it for. (2 marks)

2. My Arms and Hands: Write the Spanish words for arms and hands. What can you do with your hands? (2 marks)

3. My Legs and Feet: Write the Spanish words for legs and feet. Why are these important for playing football? (2 marks)

4. My Face: Write the Spanish words for eyes and mouth. How do you use these to communicate? (2 marks)

5. The Body Challenge: Choose two body parts and write a Spanish sentence using them, for example: 'Tengo dos ojos' (I have two eyes). (2 marks)

Extension challenge: Can you draw a portrait of yourself or a friend and label five body parts using the Spanish words from the word bank?
