

Los Días de la Semana: Rosa the Parrot's Weekly Guide

Fly into Spanish with Rosa! Can you learn the days of the week?

- **Lunes** is the first day of the school week, which means Monday.
- **Martes, miércoles, and jueves** follow in order, meaning Tuesday, Wednesday, and Thursday.
- **Viernes** is the final school day of the week, known as Friday.
- **Sábado and domingo** are the weekend days, meaning Saturday and Sunday.
- **All days of the week in Spanish end in 's' except for Wednesday, which has a special accent on the 'é'.**

Did you know? Did you know? In Spanish, the days of the week are not usually written with a capital letter at the start unless they begin a sentence! Also, the days are all masculine, which is why we use the word 'el' before them, like 'el lunes'.
