

Rosa's Weekly Spanish Calendar

Learning objective: To recall and spell the days of the week in Spanish and understand their sequence.

Read the story below about Rosa the parrot. Use the word bank to help you answer the questions about her busy week.

Rosa the parrot loves to teach her friends new words. Every week, she follows a colourful routine. On lunes, she practises her songs. On martes, she reads poetry with Leo the lion. By miércoles, she is ready to help Bea the honeybee in the garden. When jueves arrives, she maps out new places with Finn the dolphin. On viernes, she enjoys drawing patterns with Zara the zebra. The weekend is for relaxing; she rests on sábado and visits friends on domingo.

Word bank: lunes (Monday) · martes (Tuesday) · miércoles (Wednesday) · jueves (Thursday) · viernes (Friday) · sábado (Saturday) · domingo (Sunday)

1. Which day of the week does Rosa practise her songs? (1 mark)

2. Rosa meets Leo the lion on martes. What is the English name for this day? (1 mark)

3. List the two days of the weekend in Spanish. (2 marks)

4. If today is miércoles, what day was yesterday in Spanish? (1 mark)

5. Write the days of the week in order, starting with lunes. (7 marks)

Draw: Draw a picture of what you like to do on a sábado. Label your drawing with the word 'sábado' at the top.



Extension challenge: Can you write a sentence in Spanish about what you do on a specific day? For example: 'El lunes, yo juego al fútbol' (On Monday, I play football).
