

Rosa's Spanish Picnic: El Picnic de Rosa

Learning objective: To identify and categorise Spanish food vocabulary and construct simple sentences using 'Me gusta' (I like) and 'No me gusta' (I do not like).

Rosa the parrot is packing her picnic basket! Look at the food items in the word bank and sort them into the correct categories in the table below. Once you have sorted them, write three sentences about what you would pack in your own picnic using the phrase 'Me gusta...' (I like) or 'No me gusta...' (I do not like).

Word bank: la manzana (apple) · el queso (cheese) · el pan (bread) · la naranja (orange) · el plátano (banana) · el jamón (ham)

1. Complete the table: Sort the words from the word bank into 'Frutas' (Fruits) or 'Comida Salada' (Savoury Food). (6 marks)

2. Write a sentence in Spanish saying you like apples: 'Me gusta...' (2 marks)

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3. Write a sentence in Spanish saying you do not like ham: 'No me gusta...' (2 marks)

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4. Rosa wants to buy bread for £2 and an apple for £1. How much does she spend in total? (2 marks)

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5. If Rosa has a £5 note, how much change will she receive after buying the bread and apple? (2 marks)

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Draw: Draw a large picnic basket and fill it with your favourite foods. Label each item in Spanish using the words you have learned today.

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Extension challenge: Research one other Spanish food item not listed in the word bank and write a sentence explaining if you would like to try it or not.
