

Rosa's Spanish Greeting Passport

Learning objective: To learn and use common Spanish greetings and introductions appropriate for Year 4.

Rosa the parrot wants to help you become a Spanish language explorer! Use this template to practise how to greet people, introduce yourself, and ask how they are feeling in Spanish. Fill in the boxes to create your very own Spanish conversation guide.

Word bank: ¡Hola! · Buenos días · Buenas tardes · ¿Cómo estás? · Me llamo... · Encantado/a · Adiós · Gracias

1. Greeting the Sun: Write a formal Spanish greeting to use in the morning and one to use in the afternoon. (2 marks)

2. The Introduction: How do you tell someone your name in Spanish? Write the phrase and then write your own name. (2 marks)

3. Checking In: Write the Spanish question for 'How are you?' and two ways you might reply. (2 marks)

4. Being Polite: Why is it important to say 'Gracias' (thank you) when someone helps you learn a new language? (2 marks)

5. The Farewell: Rosa is flying away! Write the Spanish word for 'Goodbye' and one other polite phrase to use when leaving. (2 marks)

Extension challenge: Practise your conversation by performing a role-play with a partner. Can you add one extra sentence asking your partner where they are from using '¿De dónde eres?'
