

Rosa's Hobbies Challenge: ¡Mis Pasatiempos!

Learning objective: To learn and use Spanish vocabulary related to common hobbies and express personal preferences.

Rosa the parrot is showing off her favourite hobbies! Look at the list of Spanish hobby phrases below. Your task is to match each Spanish phrase to the correct English description. Once you have matched them, answer the questions to tell Rosa about your own favourite things to do.

Word bank: Jugar al fútbol (Playing football) · Leer libros (Reading books) · Escuchar música (Listening to music) · Dibujar (Drawing) · Nadar (Swimming) · Bailar (Dancing)

1. 1. Match the Spanish phrase 'Jugar al fútbol' to its English meaning. (1 mark)
2. 2. Which Spanish phrase would you use if you were going to the pool? (1 mark)
3. 3. Translate 'I like to read' into Spanish using the word bank: 'Me gusta...' (2 marks)
4. 4. If you wanted to say 'I like to dance', what would you write in Spanish? (2 marks)
5. 5. Rosa loves to draw. How would you say 'I like to draw' in Spanish? (2 marks)

Draw: Draw a picture of yourself doing your favourite hobby. Below your picture, write a sentence in Spanish starting with 'Me gusta...' followed by your hobby from the word bank.



Extension challenge: Can you find out how to say 'I do not like...' in Spanish? (Clue: It starts with 'No me gusta...') Write three hobbies you do not enjoy using this new phrase.
