

Rosa's Hobby Corner: ¡Mis Pasatiempos!

¡Hola! Discover the joy of hobbies with Rosa the parrot and learn to talk about what you love doing in Spanish!

- To say 'I like to draw', we use the phrase 'Me gusta dibujar'.
- When talking about playing football, we say 'Jugar al fútbol'.
- If you enjoy two different hobbies, you can use 'También' to link them together.
- Remember that in Spanish, the verb 'gustar' stays the same even if the hobby changes!
- Practise your pronunciation: 'Escuchar música' sounds like 'es-koo-char moo-see-ka'.

Did you know? Did you know? In Spanish, we use the phrase 'Me gusta' to say we like something. If you want to say you like something a lot, you can simply add 'mucho' at the end! For example: 'Me gusta leer mucho' (I like reading a lot).
