

Rosa's Spanish Number Fact-File

Learning objective: To recall and use Spanish numbers 1-20 and apply them to simple calculations and prices.

Help Rosa the parrot learn her numbers! Use this fact-file to practise writing Spanish numbers, solving mini-maths problems, and listing prices for items in a pretend market. Refer to your word bank for the correct spellings.

Word bank: uno · dos · tres · cuatro · cinco · seis · siete · ocho · nueve · diez · once · doce · trece · catorce · quince · dieciséis · diecisiete · dieciocho · diecinueve · veinte

1. Number Translation: Choose three numbers between 1 and 20. Write the digit, then write the Spanish word for it. (3 marks)

2. Maths Challenge: Rosa bought a snack for 'cinco' pounds and a book for 'diez' pounds. Write the total cost in Spanish words. (2 marks)

3. Market Prices: Imagine you are at a market. List two items and write their price in £ using Spanish words (e.g., 'ocho libras'). (2 marks)

4. Sequence Completion: Write the next two numbers in this Spanish sequence: 'diez, once, doce, ...' (2 marks)

5. Sentence Building: Write a full sentence in Spanish using one number (e.g., 'Tengo tres manzanas' - I have three apples). (3 marks)

Extension challenge: Can you write a short dialogue between you and Rosa where you tell her how old you are in Spanish?
