

Year 4 Spanish Assessment: Expressing Opinions with Rosa the Parrot

Learning objective: To use Spanish opinion phrases to describe likes and dislikes accurately.

Read each question carefully. Use the word bank to help you spell your Spanish phrases correctly. Write your answers clearly in the spaces provided.

Rosa the parrot is visiting a Spanish school today! She is asking her new friends what they like and what they do not like. Rosa loves to hear everyone express their own opinions.

Word bank: Me gusta (I like) · No me gusta (I do not like) · Me encanta (I love) · Odio (I hate) · el fútbol (football) · la pizza (pizza) · los libros (books) · el brócoli (broccoli) · los animales (animals) · el helado (ice cream)

1. Rosa asks you what you think of pizza. Write a sentence in Spanish saying 'I love pizza'. (2 marks)

2. Translate this phrase into English: 'No me gusta el brócoli'. (2 marks)

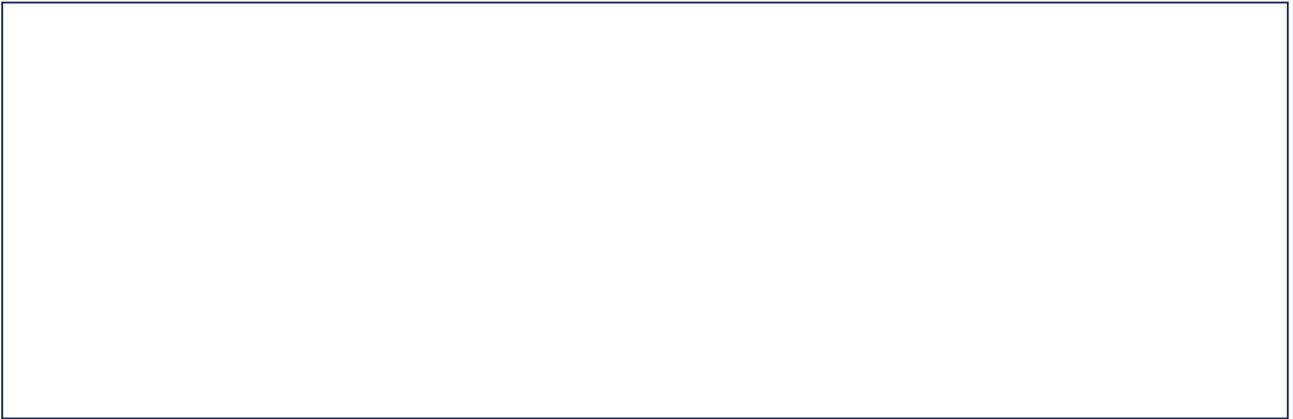
3. If someone says 'Me gusta el fútbol', are they happy or sad about football? Explain how you know. (3 marks)

4. Write one sentence using 'Me encanta' and one sentence using 'Odio'. (4 marks)

5. You are helping Rosa write a list of her favourite things. She wants to say she likes books and animals. Write two sentences in Spanish to describe her opinions. (4 marks)

6. Extended Writing Task: Imagine you are at a Spanish café. Write a short paragraph (3-4 sentences) explaining three things you like and one thing you do not like. Use a variety of opinion phrases. (10 marks)

Draw: Draw a picture of a plate of food you love and a plate of food you hate. Label the first plate with 'Me encanta...' and the second with 'Odio...'.
