

Rosa's Spanish Opinion Journal

Learning objective: To express likes and dislikes in Spanish using key opinion phrases.

Help Rosa the parrot learn your preferences! Use the Spanish opinion phrases and the word bank to fill in your journal. Remember to use 'Me gusta' for things you like and 'No me gusta' for things you dislike. You can also use 'Me encanta' if you love something!

Word bank: Me gusta (I like) · No me gusta (I do not like) · Me encanta (I love) · el fútbol (football) · la pizza (pizza) · la música (music) · los animales (animals) · el brócoli (broccoli) · los deberes (homework)

1. Choose something you like. Write a sentence in Spanish using 'Me gusta' or 'Me encanta' and explain why you enjoy it. (2 marks)

2. Choose something you do not like. Write a sentence in Spanish using 'No me gusta' and explain why you do not enjoy it. (2 marks)

3. Rosa wants to know about your favourite food. Write a sentence using 'Me encanta' followed by a food item. (1 mark)

4. Look at the word bank. Pick one activity and write a question to ask a friend if they like it, starting with '¿Te gusta...?' (2 marks)

5. Think of a new activity not in the word bank. Use a dictionary or your knowledge to write a sentence expressing your opinion about it in Spanish. (2 marks)

Extension challenge: Try to write a short paragraph of three sentences about three different things you like and dislike, using a variety of opinion phrases.
