

Mi Escuela (My School) with Rosa the Parrot

Learning objective: To identify and label common school items and rooms in Spanish.

Follow the drawing prompts below to create your own classroom scene. Once you have drawn the items, use the word bank to label them correctly in Spanish.

Draw: Create a colourful scene of a classroom. Use a clean, cartoon-style drawing. Include a table, a chair, a backpack, a notebook, and a pencil. Ensure there is plenty of space around each item to write the Spanish labels clearly. You may draw Rosa the Parrot sitting on the chair to help you with your work!



Label words: el aula (the classroom) · el cuaderno (the notebook) · el lápiz (the pencil) · la mochila (the backpack) · la mesa (the table) · la silla (the chair)

Steps:

1. Draw a large table in the centre of your page. Label this using the correct Spanish word from the word bank.
2. Rosa is sitting on a chair. Draw a chair next to the table and label it 'la silla'.
3. Draw a backpack on the floor under the table. Label it 'la mochila'.
4. Draw a notebook and a pencil on top of the table. Label them 'el cuaderno' and 'el lápiz'.
5. Write a sentence in Spanish describing one item you have drawn. For example: 'Es un lápiz.'
