

Mi Escuela (My School) with Rosa the Parrot

Learning objective: To identify and use common Spanish vocabulary related to school subjects and classroom items.

Help Rosa the parrot learn about school! Read the questions carefully and use the word bank to help you write your answers in Spanish.

Word bank: la biblioteca (library) · el patio (playground) · el aula (classroom) · las matemáticas (maths) · el arte (art) · el libro (book) · el lápiz (pencil) · la mochila (backpack)

1. Rosa is looking for her stationery to do her work. How would she say 'pencil' and 'book' in Spanish? (2 marks)

2. Max the monkey loves to solve equations. Which subject should he go to? Write your answer in Spanish. (1 mark)

3. Zara the zebra is painting a picture. What is the Spanish word for the subject 'art'? (1 mark)

4. Where do the students go to run and play during break time? Write the Spanish term for 'playground'. (1 mark)

5. If you wanted to tell a friend you are in the 'classroom', what Spanish phrase would you use from the word bank? (1 mark)

Draw: Draw a picture of your favourite school subject and label it with the correct Spanish word from the word bank.



Extension challenge: Rosa wants to pack her bag for tomorrow. Write a list of three items you would put in your 'mochila' using Spanish words, and imagine they cost £1 each. How much would they cost in total?
