

¡Vamos de Compras! (Let's Go Shopping!)

Rosa the parrot invites you to explore the local market! Can you master these phrases to help you shop with confidence?

- To ask for the price of an item, say: '¿Cuánto cuesta?'
- When the shopkeeper tells you the price, they might say: 'Cuesta tres libras' for £3.
- If something is a great deal, you can say: '¡Es muy barato!'
- If an item is too pricey, you might say: 'Es un poco caro.'
- To say 'please' when buying something, use the word: 'Por favor.'
- To say 'thank you' after your purchase, say: 'Gracias.'
