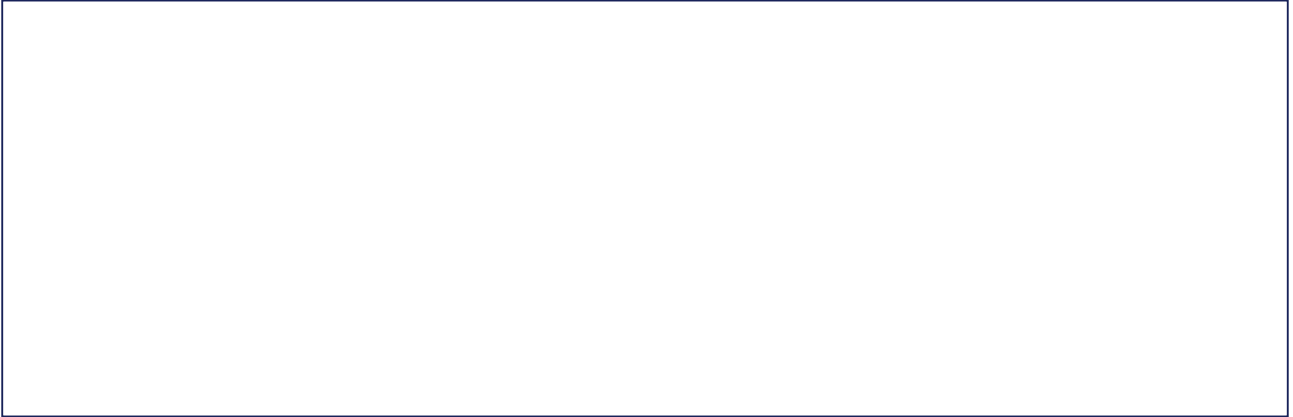
7. 7. If a bag of oranges is 'cinco libras', how much does it cost in pounds? (£) (1 mark)
